# INJURIES AND DEATH

In just five years, Fieldale Farms
Corporation's Murrayville Plant has created
a record of serious -though preventableinjuries and death among their workers.

# Aug 28, 2019

Employee walking towards a trailer to unload slipped and fell and was **hospitalized**.

No OSHA inspection.

## Dec 6, 2018

Another **sanitation worker** was preparing to clean a neck skinner machine when the employee's hand was caught in the machine rollers, resulting in **finger amputations**.

OSHA Inspection: 1366378, No citation.

## Feb 8, 2018

Another **sanitation worker** was preparing to rinse down a line with a water pressure gun when he had trouble removing the gun's water nozzle. As he attempted to remove the nozzle, the high-pressure water shot into and **lacerated the inside of his mouth**.

No OSHA inspection.

# May 8, 2017

An employee's **right forearm was caught and fractured** in a moving conveyor belt, requiring hospitalization.

No OSHA inspection.

## Mar 8, 2016

Another employee who was performing sanitation work entered the picking room. There was fog in the room. The employee stumbled and entered a flow of steam from water that was draining out of the scalder tank. He suffered severe burns on his left leg, ankle, and foot, requiring overnight hospitalization.

No OSHA inspection

## Jan 15, 2020

Chit Tuay, a **sanitation worker** fell into the scalder that he was cleaning and **broke his neck**, resulting in his **death**.

## Aug 8, 2019

An employee slipped and fell, resulting in a hip fracture and admission to hospital.

No OSHA inspection.

#### Oct 2018

The plant gets a waiver to increase line speeds.

## Mar 2, 2018

An employee was manually feeding bags into a machine when his left index finger was caught and partially amputated between the machine's belt and sprocket. OSHA issued citation for not implementing required safety precautions.

OSHA Inspection: 1300335.

## Nov 6, 2017

An employee was loading a partial roll of film on a bagging machine when a bar fell from one end of the machine. The employee's right middle fingertip was caught and amputated between the bar and the roll of film.

No OSHA inspection.

# Jan 2017

A **sanitation employee** was using a high pressure hose to wash a conveyor belt. His smock got caught in a sprocket on the machine resulting in an **upper right arm fracture**.

No OSHA inspection.

# Jul 7, 2015

An employee was performing maintenance on fluorescent lights. He contacted an electrical wire with his screwdriver and was **electrocuted and killed**. OSHA cited the company for failing to insulate the wiring and leaving the light on while worker was working on it.

OSHA inspection: 1075821.015.
